

**National Children's Study-Health Measurement Network Year 1 (Oct 2011 to Sept 2012) Aims**

**Aim 1: Develop an organizational architecture for the NCS Health Measurement Network that supports a community of scholars interested in advancing the science of health measurement.**

**Aim 2: Field test NIH Toolbox and PROMIS instruments among women and children.**

**Aim 3: Develop a working theoretical model of health that drives innovation; a working typology of health domains mapped to current NCS instruments; and a consensus-derived prioritization of child and maternal health domains.**

**Aim 4: Provide informatics support to enable portability of final health profile measures across NCS IMS platforms**

**Aim 5: Select theoretically driven maternal and child health measures for high priority domains.**

**Aim 6: Develop, evaluate, and validate final list of prioritized and innovation health profile measures.**

**Aim 7: Field test the health profiles, assess their construct validity, and develop integrated summary scores and profile-type taxonomy.**
